According to Scholastic, research shows that reading just six books during the summer may help keep a struggling reader from regressing. When choosing books, be sure that they are just right . . . not too hard and not too easy. Take advantage of your local library. Ask for help selecting books that match your child's interests, and abilities. Libraries often run summer reading programs that motivate kids to read, so find out what's available in your area! We want your child to read MORE this summer! Your child's classroom teacher and I are encouraging students to play READO. It is played just like BINGO. Attached you will find a READO card for June and July. Every day your child completes an activity put the date in the box. Try getting a READO diagonally, horizontally, or vertically. A READO is when you complete 5 boxes in a row.

Return the signed READO cards by August 23 to your child's new classroom teacher. Children who complete at least 4 READOs in June and 4 READOs in July will receive a prize. Remember a READO is not simply 4 boxes completed. It is 4 columns or rows completed. See example.
